PREAMBLE

MAS Corporation (Pty) Ltd t/a Mascor (“we”, “us”) operates <http://www.mascor.co.za> (“the Site”). It is Mascor’s intension for you to have a safe and enjoyable experience on the Site. This document serves to disclose our policies regarding the collection and use of personal information that we may receive from users who visit the <http://www.mascor.co.za> Website.

We use this information to improve your experience on the Site. By using <http://www.mascor.co.za>, you agree to the collection and use of information in accordance with this policy.

In terms of Section 11 of the Electronic Communications and Transactions (ECT) Act 25 of 2002 (http://www.acts.co.za/ect_act/) and the common law of contract, these terms and conditions are valid, binding and enforceable against all persons that access the Mascor Website, web pages or any part thereof.

It is your responsibility to familiarize yourself with these Terms and Conditions and agree to them if you wish to continue your visit to <http://www.mascor.co.za>.

DEFINITIONS AND INTERPRETATION

1. **“the Mascor Website”** or **“the Website”** means the Mascor Website, owned and operated by MAS Corporation (Pty) Ltd and located at <http://www.mascor.co.za>, including any page, part or element thereof;
2. **“Mascor”** means **MAS Corporation (Pty) Ltd**, <http://www.mascor.co.za>, registration number 1996/000999/07;
3. **“personal information”** may refer to your general geographic location, contact information, first and last names, and any other information you may be required to complete in order to view certain parts of the Website, complete forms and complete general enquiries;
4. **“features”/“functionality”** may refer to the pop up items when viewing certain content or making general enquiries, search options and elements relating to hyperlinks and/or styling components;
5. **“hyperlink”** refers to a clickable link from the Webpage you would be on that is linked to a different part of the page, Website or even to a completely different Web site/page.
 - a. The validity of a hyperlink as a reference mechanism is dependent on validity of the referenced Website, Web page, image or data. The hyperlink has no way of knowing whether a Website, web page or any content therein still exists;
 - b. Hyperlinks that are non-operational does not affect the validity and interpretation of these terms and conditions.

COLLECTION OF PERSONAL INFORMATION

It is possible for Mascor to receive your personal information in two ways:

1. Forms that you willingly complete
2. Cookies used by the Mascor Website

WHAT ARE COOKIES

Cookies are tiny files that are downloaded to your computer, to improve your experience. This document outlines how we collect cookies, why we collect cookies and what you can do to disable cookies.

HOW WE USE COOKIES

We use cookies for a variety of reasons detailed below. Unfortunately in most cases there are no industry standard options for disabling cookies without completely disabling the functionality and features they add to this site. It is recommended that you leave on all cookies if you are not sure whether you need them or not in case they are used to provide a service that you use.

DISABLING COOKIES

You can prevent the setting of cookies by adjusting the settings on your browser (see your browser Help for how to do this). Be aware that disabling cookies will affect the functionality of this and many other websites that you visit. Disabling cookies will usually result in also disabling certain functionality and features of this site. Therefore it is recommended that you do not disable cookies.

THE COOKIES WE SET

We use cookies when you are logged in so that we can remember this. This prevents you from having to log in every single time you visit a new page. These cookies are typically removed or cleared when you log out to ensure that you can only access restricted features and areas when logged in.

When you submit data through a form such as those found on contact pages cookies may be set to remember your user details for future correspondence.

In order to provide you with a great experience on this site we provide the functionality to set your preferences for how this site runs when you use it. In order to remember your preferences we need to set cookies so that this information can be called whenever you interact with a page that is affected by your preferences.

THIRD PARTY COOKIES

In some special cases we also use cookies provided by trusted third parties. The following section details which third party cookies you might encounter through this site.

This site uses **Google Analytics** which is one of the most widespread and trusted analytics solution on the web for helping us to understand how you use the site and ways that we can improve your experience. These cookies may track things such as how long you spend on the site and the pages that you visit so we can continue to produce engaging content.

Third party analytics are used to track and measure usage of this site so that we can continue to produce engaging content. These cookies may track things such as how long you spend on the site or pages you visit which helps us to understand how we can improve the site for you.

From time to time we test new features and make subtle changes to the way that the site is delivered. When we are still testing new features these cookies may be used to ensure that you receive a consistent experience whilst on the site whilst ensuring we understand which optimisations our users appreciate the most.
